



2009 AANA Foundation Scholarship Program

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Scholarships are available to all nurse anesthesia students*.
2. Applicants must be **AANA members currently enrolled in an accredited nurse anesthesia education program in good standing.**
3. First year students must have completed six (6) months of nurse anesthesia classes by March 15, 2009. Second year students must have completed twelve (12) months of nurse anesthesia classes by March 15, 2009.
4. Each scholarship may have specific requirements that the applicant must meet. (See the attached table for these requirements).
5. All attachments must be included with your submitted application except for the Program Verification Form which must arrive via mail or email.
6. Additional documents will not be accepted after the application has been submitted.
7. All applications must be **postmarked or emailed by March 16, 2009.**

**Student refers to an individual currently attending a nurse anesthesia program. The nurse anesthesia program must be included on the current list of Recognized Educational Programs accredited by the Council on Accreditation of Nurse Anesthesia Educational Programs.*

Notification:

Applicants are notified of receipt of their applications via a confirmation email. The Winner and Non-winner notifications will all be e-mailed on the same day and our goal is to have these sent out no later than the week of June 1, 2009. **Please do not call the Foundation office asking about Notification.**

Applying for more than one scholarship:

CRNA students can apply for more than one scholarship. Please make sure you indicate in Section 2 which scholarships you are applying for. **The application fee is \$25 for the first scholarship and \$10.00 for each additional scholarship.**
