The GANA is kicking off a grass roots GANA-PAC Fundraising Drive! Between now and December 15, 2009 members of the GANA Board and other selected individuals will be personally contacting the approximately 1100 members of the Georgia Association of Nurse Anesthetists to solicit GANA-PAC donations.

The GANA-PAC stays within Georgia to protect the rights to practice of our local CRNAs. Its funds are not used for meetings, board members or board expenses, but strictly for donations to State Senators and Representatives who support the goals of Georgia CRNAs.

CRNAs practice with the freedom they have because of current laws, including the Nurse Practice Act and the Medical Practice Act protocols. The Board of Medicine is currently reviewing protocol and we have to be prepared for proposed changes. We cannot allow any restrictions to our current practice.

Supporting your profession and organization through financial donations to GANA-PAC is not just a good idea, but it is an expectation of each member of the organization. As a prestigious profession, we must make ourselves visible and audible to the Georgia government first, and then on a national level. What better way to do so, especially if you are not able to personally lobby with GANA at the State Capitol.
